

Waverly Community House Student Volunteer Registry

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Waverly Community House?

The Comm is a full service community center located at 1115 N. Abington Road in Waverly, Pa. It is fully staffed from 9:00am until 5:00pm and features many programs and activities for the community.

What is the Student Volunteer Registry?

It is a program sponsored by the Comm to give local students the opportunity to perform community service work in a local, supervised and familiar environment.

What type of community service work is available?

The Comm offers community service work for all ages and interests. You may perform as many hours as you like. You may assist with special events, children's programs, help with office work or with the grounds, among many other things.

What are the hours?

Volunteer hours must be performed between 9am and 4:30pm Monday thru Friday. Volunteer hours may be completed on a weekend to coincide with an event, such as the Bunny Breakfast or Artisan's Marketplace. Community service hours must be supervised by Comm staff or adult volunteers.

What do I need to do to volunteer?

Contact Mrs. Maria Wilson, Executive Director at 586-8191 ext 1 to inquire what is available and to sign up. Parental permission is required. Either return this FAQ sheet signed or visit www.waverlycomm.org to download a parental permission slip and bring it with you when you arrive to complete your work. STUDENTS AGED 18 and over must produce this prior to completing their hours.

Will someone verify that I completed the volunteer hours?

Yes, you will be given a service log which will be signed upon completion of the hours.
