

Participant, Student, and Guest Code of Conduct

We expect persons using the Waverly Community House programs and facilities to behave in a mature and responsible way, and to respect the rights and dignity of others. Our code of conduct does not permit language or any action that can hurt or frighten another person, or that falls below a generally acceptable standard of conduct.

The following activities are prohibited in all Waverly Community House and Comm Camp facilities and programs:

- Inappropriate communication, either verbal or written.
- Unduly disruptive behavior.
- Insubordination or defiance of authorized program directors or counselors.
- Inappropriate attire. Appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
- Angry or vulgar language, including swearing, name-calling, or shouting.
- Physical contact with another person in any angry or threatening manner.
- Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual contact with another person.
- Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language, or any menacing behavior.
- Racist or discriminatory behavior of any kind.
- Theft or behavior that results in the destruction of property.
- Carrying or concealing any weapons, or devices or objects that may be used as weapons.
- Using or possessing illegal chemicals or alcohol on Waverly Community House property or at Comm sponsored programs.
- Any other kind of inappropriate, threatening, or offensive nature.
- Smoking is not permitted.

Members, participants, and guests are encouraged to be responsible for their personal comfort and safety, and to ask any person who threatens their comfort to refrain. If a member, participant, or guest feels uncomfortable in confronting the person directly, they should report the behavior to the Comm Camp directors, or another staff person.

A member, participant, or guest who is in violation of the code of conduct could be subject to consequences including suspension and/or removal from a program or activity including any Comm Camp Programs. There will be no refunds.
