Our Program

Our Philosophy: The Comm has a long standing commitment to Early Childhood Education that dates all the way back to our first kindergarten class in 1921. Our children's programs reflect Paul Belin's idea of "education through recreation," something we believe wholeheartedly. We focus on the growth and well being of the whole child, both intellectually, and socially and emotionally.
