

Class Schedules & Tuition Rates

Kindergarten Program: AM & PM Classes

Waverly & Clarks Summit Elementary Students Only

Half Day: \$40 per day or \$110 for the week

8:00am-12:00pm for PM Kinder and 11:30am-3:00pm for AM Kinder

Full Day: \$50 per day or \$190 for the week

8:00am-12:00pm & 3:00pm-6:00pm for PM Kinder, and 11:30am-after 3:00pm for AM Kinder

*Transportation is provided by Comm Kids to school for PM Kindergarten (Waverly & CSE) and after school for AM Kindergarten (Waverly only)

After School Program 1st-6th Grades 2:30pm-6:00pm

Waverly & Clarks Summit Elementary Students Only

Daily Rate: \$40 for the first child \$35 for each subsequent child

Weekly Rate: \$110 for the first child \$105 for each subsequent child

*Transportation provided by bus from the Abington Heights School District

Registration:

\$50 deposit required upon admittance to the program

Medical Forms, signed by a physician, with up to date immunizations required. Must be submitted with registration in September and provided annually with updated vaccination records required in February.

Welcome to Comm Kids!

Our Philosophy: The Comm has a long standing commitment to Early Childhood Education that dates all the way back to our first kindergarten class in 1921. Our children's programs reflect Paul Belin's idea of "education through recreation," something we believe wholeheartedly. We focus on the growth and well-being of the whole child, both intellectually, and socially and emotionally. Children learn in a multitude of ways, and we make it our mission to incorporate as many of those ways into our curriculum as possible.

Admission Policy: Classes are limited in size. A waiting list will be kept in the order applications are received, and will open in late September for the following school year. Acceptance to the program will be offered in late February. Admissions and the provision of services shall be made without regard to race, color, religious creed, disability, ancestry, national origin (including limited English proficiency) or sex.

Weather Cancellation and Holiday Closure Policy: All Comm Kids Programs follow the Abington Heights School District in regards to snow closures/delays, and closed holidays/teacher in-service days. We do not offer childcare for snow days.

Health and Safety: Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well. Additionally, please report any contagious diseases in your household, as well as any medications your child is currently taking. Children MUST be accompanied to and from the classroom by an adult. If your child will be picked up by someone other than yourself, please inform the director.

Payment: Tuition can be paid via check, credit card, or Venmo and is due by Friday in advance of the following week.

Cards will be charged in advance of the first of the month. **Payment will be required regardless of if Comm Kids has a scheduled closure or not.**

Kindergarten Program

Planned Lessons: Comm Kids Kindergarten offers supplemental instruction to the Abington Heights School District.. Special attention is given to the development of reasoning, organization, social and emotional development. and fine and gross motor skills. Arts, music and literature are incorporated daily.

Specials: Children are engaged monthly in a variety of special classes such as Art, Spanish, and Sign Language.

Outdoor Play: This is an important part of our daily program! Please make sure to dress your child in appropriate clothes for outdoor play everyday.

Guided Free Play: During this activity, children work on their social and emotional skills, specifically how to share and work together with others, problem solve, and communicate effectively.

Homework Help: AM kindergarten students, and PM kindergarten students who return for after school care will be provided homework help upon parent request.

After School Program

Snack Time: Allergy safe, individually packaged snacks will be provided daily. Students are welcome to bring their own snacks should they prefer, but all snacks must be Peanut and Tree Nut free.

Outdoor Play: This is an important part of our daily program! Please make sure to dress your child in appropriate clothes for outdoor play everyday.

Homework Help: All students who attend after school care will be provided homework help upon parent request.
